

## Parent FAQ

How we are proceeding with Kids Groups for preschool with current regulations?

- We are using a similar format to local daycare's
  - All kids and volunteers will take and pass COVID self-assessment before coming.
  - All kids/volunteers wash hands as they come into small group rooms.
  - Only leaders for the small group are in the room, no one else (creating a cohort for that morning) with the exception of one parent if necessary to calm their child.
  - Every attempt will be made to create activities that offer physical distancing as best we can.
  - Toys/surfaces wiped down as needed during the morning activities
  - Hand washing continuing during the morning when necessary
  - Toys that have been played with in the mouth will be removed when child is done playing with it.
  - All toys, chairs, tables and other touchable surfaces will be sterilized after each Kids Groups morning event.

Will we have Kids Groups online for the rest of the year? Yes

Will Family Church continue (children's feature in Big Church)? Yes, until a plan is in place for Grade 1 to 6 Kids Groups.

What time does Preschool Kids Groups start? Sign in begins at 9:15 to 9:30. Sign out at 10:30 to 10:45.

What does a typical morning look like in Preschool?

- Playtime
- Praise and Worship
- Bible story
- Craft

Will singing will be allowed in small group? Yes

Will leaders will be holding children that need to be consoled in small group? Yes, for age 2's and 3's if necessary.

Are masks required? Not at this time. Children and volunteers are absolutely allowed to wear them if they choose.

Are thermometers being used to temperature/screen? No

Are parents/guardians allowed in the small group rooms? 1 parent/guardian is allowed in small group rooms if needed to sooth and prepare a child to be left with the leader. Additional family members (siblings) are asked to stay outside of the small group room.
